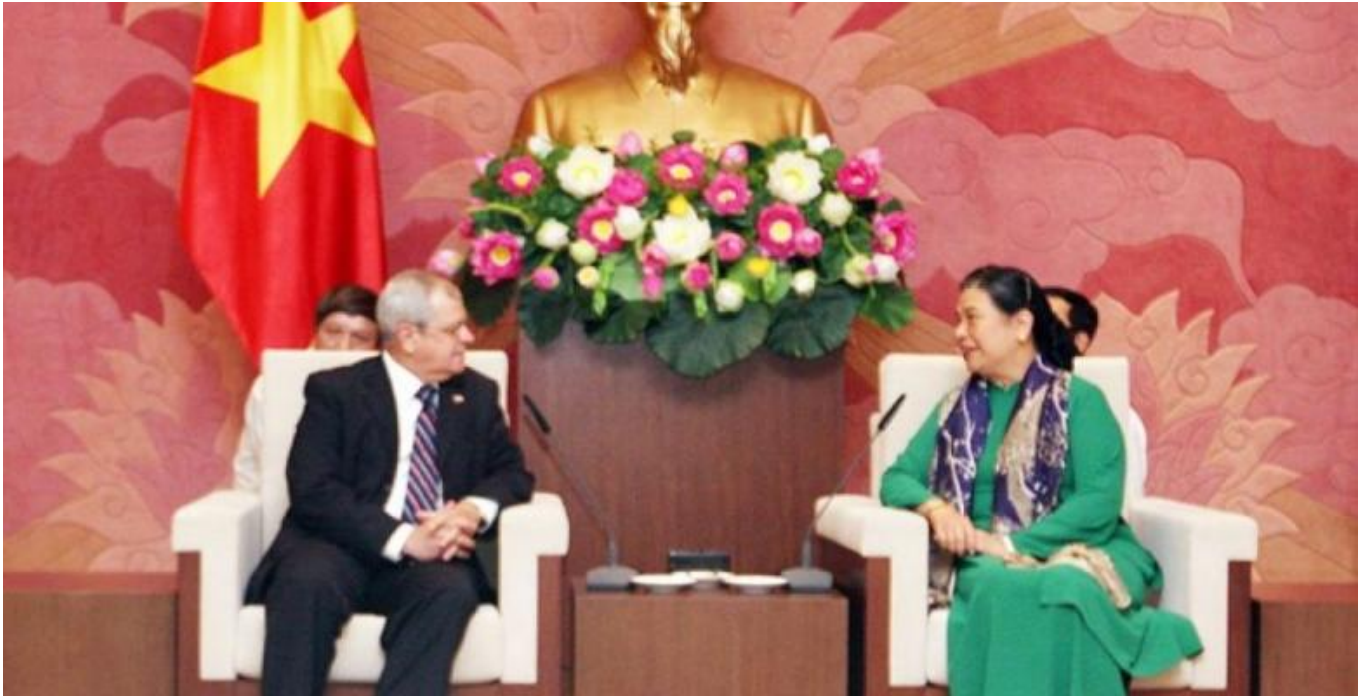

NA Vice Chairwoman welcomes Cuban parliamentary delegation
