
First Sommelier Cuban Woman Writes About Her Impressions

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The first Cuban sommelier woman, presents her impressions of this work in a text that appears today at the 26th International Book Fair 2017, based in the Morro-Cabaña tourist complex of this city.

For the expert Martha Beatriz Seán, this document, titled *El Donaire*, allowed her, in a direct and pleasant style, to show her experiences in the recreational sector of this archipelago.
