US Republicans Send Letter to Trump Urging Cuba Remain Open

According to the ABC News website, they are deeply concerned by reports the administration is leaning toward reversing the Cuba policy initiated by former President Barack Obama (2009-2017).

According to ABC, the US National Security Council met today in order to finalize its policy and recommendations for the Directors Committee and then submitting the suggestions on Cuba to the president.

On April 20, over a dozen retired US military officers urged Donald Trump National Security Adviser Herbert

McMaster to continue the path toward normalization with Cuba.
