


Cuba is not afraid, president says about attack on embassy in US

President Miguel Díaz-Canel affirmed today that Cuba does not fear in clear allusion to the terrorist attack against the island's embassy in Washington, the capital of the United States.

Terrorist acts will not annihilate the value bequeathed by our heroes. Cuba is not afraid, Cuba is not giving up, the president wrote in his Twitter account when commenting on the events of the past day 30 at the headquarters of Havana in the northern country.

At dawn on the 30th, an individual attacked the exterior of the Cuban Embassy in the United States with an assault rifle. At the moment a dozen officials were at headquarters. There were no injuries but material damage.

Remember April, added the head of state, sharing an article in the Granma newspaper that recalled hostile actions by the White House against the Caribbean nation in the fourth month of the year, such as the attack on Playa Girón (known as the Bay of Pigs)).

The message was accompanied by the hashtags #SomosCuba and #SomosContinuidad.

There were thousands of squares vibrating with emotion, enthusiasm and love, the dignitary explained in another tweet when referring to the celebration of May 1, International Workers' Day.
