

Cuba walks off with Pan Am bronze in baseball

The Pan American Games men's baseball bronze medal is going back to Cuba.

Back-to-back ninth inning home runs off the bats of Yorbis Borroto and Jose Garcia lifted Cuba to a 7-6 walk-off win over Puerto Rico in the bronze medal contest on Sunday.

Puerto Rico led 6-3 going into the ninth, but Raul Rivera couldn't nail down the save, giving up two singles followed by the two home runs.

Cuban reliever Yennier Cano was credited with the win after throwing two innings of shutout baseball.

It is the 15th medal that Cuba has won at the Pan Am Games, dominating the competition with 12 gold, one silver and two bronze.

Cuba starts with a win against Chinese Taipei

Cuba did start the World Port Tournament very well. In the evening match on Sunday, July 19 Cubans took the lead in the first inning on a 2-0.

In the second and third inning the scored another run. Despite the good play on the part of Chinese Taipei, they only managed to score one run in both the sixth and eighth inning. The formation of head coach Victor Mesa did not allow anymore runs.
