
Cuba, Finland Restructure Cuba's Debt

The vice president of Cuban Council of Ministers Ricardo Cabrisas and the Finnish Under-Secretary of State of Foreign Ministry Pirkko Hamalainen, signed today an agreement to restructure Cuba's debt with that country.

According to a statement, during the meeting both sides had a fruitful exchange of views regarding the positive state of bilateral relations and its development prospects.

Hamalainen was accompanied by Finland's ambassador in Mexico, concurring in Cuba, Roy Eriksson; and other officials of the Finnish Foreign Ministry.
