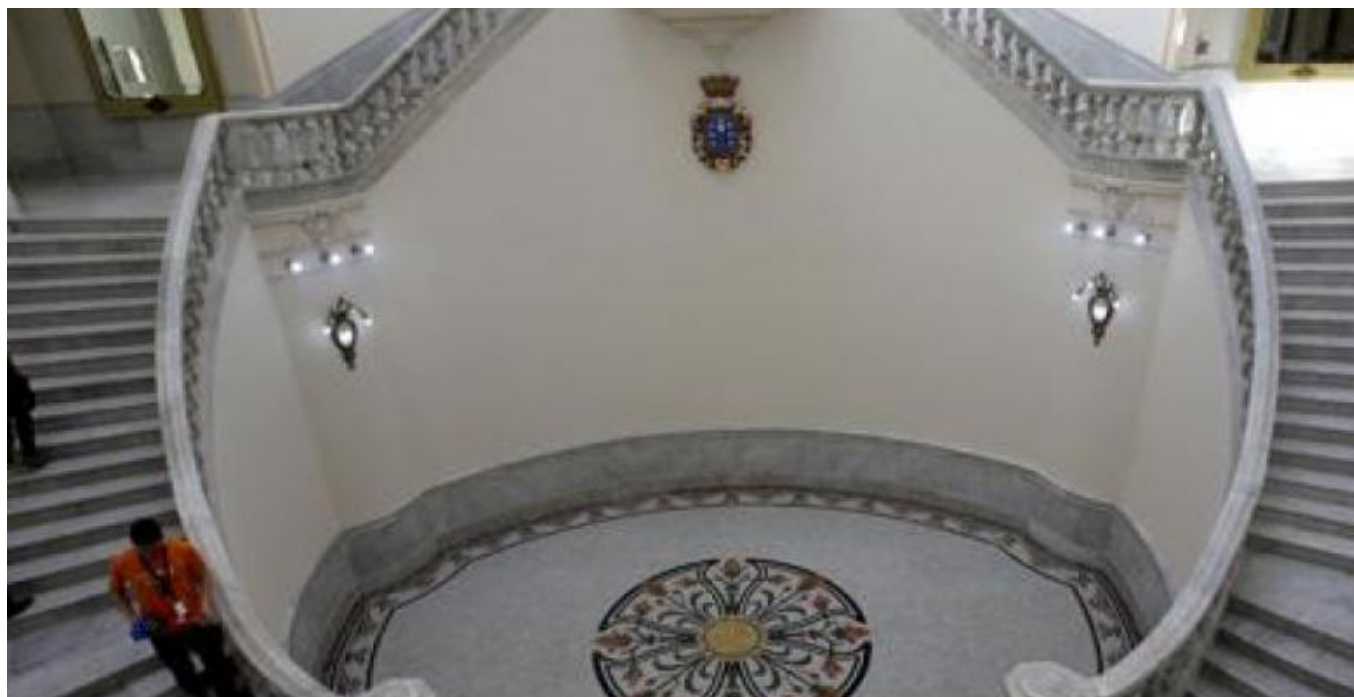

Musica Eterna Chamber Orchestra at Lecuona Room
