

Violence in Syria's Aleppo Kills at Least 333 Civilians Last Month

Among those victims, at least 147 were killed by airstrikes against neighborhoods under the control of opposition factions such as al-Kalasa, al-Moghayer and al-Ansari in Aleppo.

Other 162 civilians, including 43 minors and 38 women, perished by rockets and gas cylinder missiles launched by Islamic State against government-held towns like al-Zahra, al-Midan and al-Sulaymaniya.

Additionally, 11 people were killed by Syrian regime artillery in several towns in Aleppo, and another was killed by a sniper in the al-Zabdie neighborhood.

The London-based NGO said four civilians were killed by armed Islamist organizations shelling against the Shiitedominated Shaikh Maqsoud area.

Meanwhile, snipers of the Syrian Democratic Forces killed two people in Helik neighborhood in Aleppo.

Another six victims, including three children, died in the explosion of a mortar factory in al-Sukkari town.
