
11 injured in Bolivia by attack man with mental problems

Deputy Minister of Government Jorge Perez reported that nine of the victims were admitted to nearby airfield hospitals with serious injuries. "Man came from a village, suffers from mental illness and approached a ticketing counter and began to attack with knife "to passengers and family addressing domestic flights, said.

The subject was identified with the name Javier Virgilio Cussi Aduviri, 40 years old, Perez who explained that Cussi was apprehended by federal EI AI for the crime of "murder in the attempted" because he attacked with weapon white.

"There is a lack of coordination of the subject of what he says and what happened at the airport as they first said it was in the place to buy tickets for Chile, but said that was a mandate beyond, because the people (victims) were hens," said an official of the drive against crime.

According to witnesses, Cussi of Aymara origin, arrived at the airport with strange attitude in seconds and attacked several people without a word, mostly women. His defense has argued that schizophrenia-like mental problems "is not a terrorist, he is mentally ill and want to go to a mental health home," said the lawyer Monica Irusta.
