

Vietnam, Cuba To Boost Defence Ties

Officers from Vietnam's Defence Ministry and Cuba's Ministry of the Revolutionary Armed Forces (MINFAR) have agreed to further step up the bond between the two agencies in a more practical and effective manner, Vietnam News Agency (VNA) reports.

During a defence policy dialogue in Havana, Thursday, the two sides discussed orientations for their future links, towards the signing of a cooperation plan in the time ahead.
